Work-Able is a workplace quality standard for organisations who demonstrate disability confidence in meeting the needs of disabled employees at work

Work-Able has;

- Recruited a team of workplace auditors
- Conducted five workplace audit assessments
- Awarded five quality standard plaques
- Designed a website and employer self assessment



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Work-Able has;

- Trained 4 former students with disabilities to become workplace assessors
- Created five employer good practice case studies
- Published five news stories of employer good practice
